
Necessary material: Carbon cloth 200 g/m2 -530x230 –diagonal cut, Resin MGS L 285 +H286



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WORK PROCEDURE

- 1. Secure rocket activation handle
- 2. Disconnect rocket cable from parachute.
- 3. Dismantle rocket from the bulkhead and lay it down onto fuselage floor
- 4. Dismantle shoulder harness
- 5. Sand varnished structure in accordance to scheme and clean dust



6. Make lay up of 1 layer C200 diagonaly



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- 7. Trim excessive layup after cure. Clean fuselage and reinstall shoulder harness and rocket.
- 8. Connect rocket cable to parachute and secure it on rocket case using thin nylon cable tie in accordance to picture



9. Attach rescue system cover using elastic 15 mm wide tape

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
